

Her work and her writing have been featured in Artforum, Artnews, Chicago Magazine, and Texte zur Kunst; Bauer Verlag will publish a forthcoming book of her prose in 2022. Leiby received a BFA from the School of the Art Institute Chicago, and studied with Amy Sillman and Monika Baer at the Städelschule, Frankfurt.
